JESUS CHRIST THE KING IS ALIVE! (Part 2)

After Jesus died on the cross and was buried, it seemed like it was all over. However, after three days in the tomb of Joseph of Arimathea, Matthew 28, Mark 16, Luke 24, and John 20 teaches that Jesus Christ the King is alive! The resurrection is necessary to promote the validity of our Christian faith. The death, burial and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ is not a matter of philosophy but of history and more importantly, it is a matter of the gospel and saving faith.
